Intent

At Bowes Hutchinson's C of E VA Primary, we believe that high-quality history lessons inspire children to want to know more about the past and their place in History.

By linking their History learning to a range of topics, children have opportunities to investigate and interpret the past, understand chronology building an overview of Britain's past as well as that of the wider world.

We develop children with the following characteristics:

- An excellent knowledge and understanding of people, events and contexts from a range of historical periods, including significant events in Britain's past;
- A developing sense of curiosity about the past and how and why people interpret the past in different ways.
- The ability to think critically about history and communicate ideas confidently to a range of audiences;
- A respect for historical evidence and the ability to make critical use of it to support their learning;
- A developing sense of curiosity about the past and how and why people interpret the past in different ways.

The children are taught to value their home and heritage within the local community and link this to their place within British and World History.

Implementation:

- A cycle of lessons for each subject, which carefully plans for progression and depth;
- Trips and visits which will broaden and enhance the children's learning experience;

Impact:
